OUR VISION

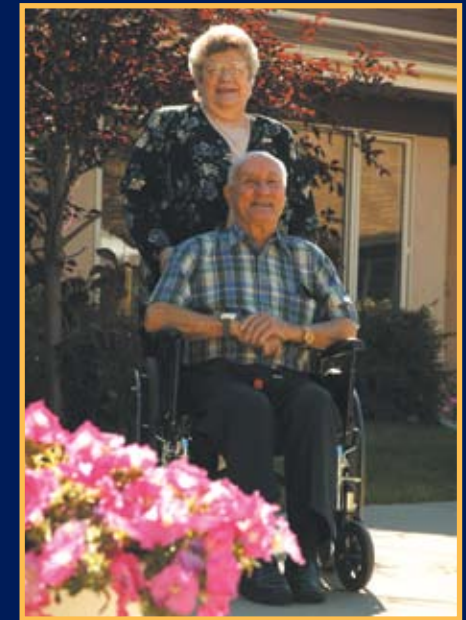

South Ridge Village, owned and operated by The Good Samaritan Society, is a unique community offering seniors multiple levels of support and the opportunity to age in place.

Continuing Care

South Ridge Village provides services to residents in private rooms, each with a wheelchair accessible bathroom and shower. The Good Samaritan Society will provide an appropriate style bed, night table, dresser and side chair.

Residents are encouraged to personalize their rooms with their own belongings such as a chair, lamp, pictures, quilt or bedspread, etc. Admission to continuing care is coordinated through the Palliser Health Region (PHR) Placement Coordinator.

Dementia Care

There are three - ten bed dementia care cottages at South Ridge Village. Our dementia cottages are unique duplexes designed to create a home-like setting for up to ten dementia clients in each cottage. Each side of the duplex has five bedrooms, living room with fireplace, kitchen, and secure access to the fenced yard. Clients are included in the events of daily living to the extent that they are accustomed and able. Admission may be coordinated through the Palliser Health Region (PHR)-Placement Coordinator.



Assisted Living

The Assisted Living Program at South Ridge Village provides accommodation and personal care services to residents in private suites.

The program offers residents the flexibility to prepare their own breakfast and lunch in their own suite if they choose. Residents rent includes housekeeping and linen service and Telecare emergency response system. Optional services such as meals, personal laundry service, cable TV, may be purchased. Call South Ridge Village for further information (403-528-5050) concerning both private assisted living and designated assisted living (funded through PHR).

Personal Pathways Day Program

The Personal Pathways Day Program offers services to client Monday to Friday exclusive of statutory holidays. Participants may attend from one to five days per week depending on individual need. Eligibility into the program may be referred by the Palliser Health Region Home Care. Services include daytime caregiver respite, personal care assistance, bathing, social/recreational activities and health promotion. Participants are served a tasty and nutritious meal at lunchtime.
