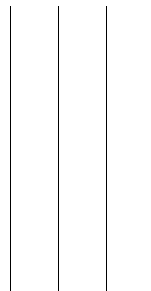

How It All Started...

In 1949 Gottlieb Wedman, a farmer from Leduc, Alberta, made a \$7000 donation that truly made a difference. With these funds an “old folk’s home” was established for those who had no place to go when they could no longer care for themselves. Members of the Lutheran community united to build and operate Alberta’s first Auxiliary Hospital. Over the years, thousands of individuals have benefited from this gift of kindness and caring.

From those humble beginnings, The Good Samaritan Society has expanded its services throughout Alberta and British Columbia and is the largest not-for-profit continuing care provider in Canada. The Good Samaritan Society offers services and programs in the areas of supportive, home and facility based living to more than 4000 residents and clients. Since 1949 The Good Samaritan Society has created specially designed and caring environments for the elderly or disabled and has played a key role in the development of new and innovative programs – ones that have become the industry standard throughout Canada.

The Call To Help

As with Gottlieb Wedman years ago, donations to The Society continue to create remarkable changes and opportunities.

Through the years, individuals have donated money to show their appreciation for the caring and compassionate services received by The Good Samaritan Society. These donations have helped to improve the quality of life for our clients. Donations enable The Society to purchase much needed items that enhance the work we do.
